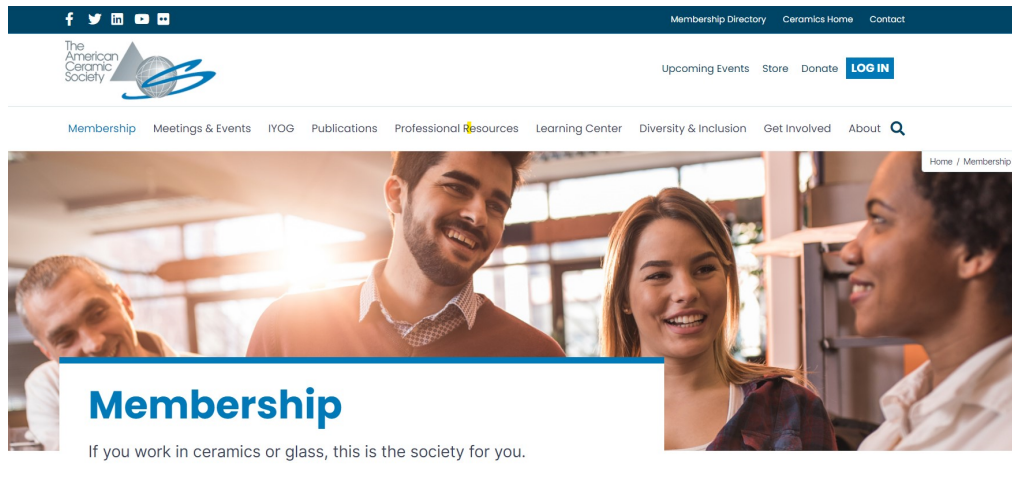


First of all, you need to understand each type of member before you can study from the web page. <https://ceramics.org/members/membership-types>
